DIRECTIONS

PICNIC AT PATAPSCO VALLEY STATE PARK

Avalon/Glen Artney/Orange Grove Areas

5120 South St., Halethorpe, MD 21227

From the Beltway (I-695) Take Rt.1 (Exit 12-A) toward Elkridge.
Follow Rt. 1 South about 3 miles to South St. Turn right. Park entrance is on the left.

From I -95 Take I-195 to Rt.1 (Exit 3) toward Elkridge to South St. Turn right.
Park entrance is on the left.

From Howard County Follow Rt.1 through Elkridge and into Baltimore County.
Turn left onto South St. Park entrance is on the left.

INSIDE THE PARK: Use carpools because of limited parking near Shelter #66.
At the gate, pay park admission/car (ask for a map and park directions if you like).
Drive .7 miles to the "T"; turn right and drive through the stone tunnel. You will come to
a fork; stay to your left and follow signs to Upper Glen Artney. Continue on left and
drive uphill, following around a loop road. Follow the road until you reach
Upper Glen Artney, Shelter #66.
